PROTECT CARNARVON GOLF COURSE & COLEMAN PARK

To the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of New South Wales
The petition of the supporters and residents of New South Wales brings to the attention of the House:

That the electorate of Auburn already has the largest cemetery in the Southern Hemisphere. Since 1927, Carnarvon Golf Course and Coleman Park have been one of the most important sporting precincts servicing communities in Western Sydney. It is noteworthy that these sporting facilities were a crucial part of the decision by the NSW Government to include Berala and Lidcombe as Transport Orientated Development precincts.

The inclusion of the land on which these essential sporting facilities sit, as a potential cemetery by the MMP will alienate these sporting facilities from one of the poorest communities in NSW.

The undersigned petitioners ask the Legislative Assembly to:

- 1. Direct Metropolitan Memorial Parks to remove the lands on which Carnarvon Golf Course and Coleman Park sit from their list of potential cemetery expansion sites.
- 2. Direct the NSW Government to honour their parklands commitments as part of their TODs.
- 3. Require MMP to consider other potential cemetery sites outside a "30 minute" drive from the inner suburbs of Sydney.
