- MASTER PLAN PROPOSALS**
01. Additional picnic shelters located in proximity to existing shelters and barbecues.
 02. Resurface area to create a 'picnic plaza', replaces worn uneven grass areas with a stabilised gravel surface.
 03. Install connecting concrete paths to picnic shelters from main paths to provide all weather and accessible routes.
 04. Rationalisation of path surfacing and routes - continue staged pathway network upgrade from gravel to asphalt and brick edging (stage one implemented from eastern pedestrian entry to playground entries).
 05. Rationalisation of existing drainage swales and culverts throughout park - a. regrade swales so they are more efficient; b. replace swales with piped drainage adjacent high activity areas.
 06. Proposed filling and regrading of sunken fill areas.
 07. Controlled vehicular access.
 08. New fence along southern boundary.
 09. New junior play / water play item or landscape feature.
 10. Redeveloped inclusive play area.
 11. Outdoor fitness area with shade structure.
 12. Improve amenity and setting - additional garden beds and seating.
 13. New outdoor / parkour equipment.
 14. New path connection.
 15. Revegetation of riparian corridor.
 16. New dog off-leash facility.
 17. Event staging area with 3 phase power box.
 18. Upgrade toilet block with new forecourt seating.
 19. Revegetation perimeter screen planting.
 20. Reconfigure orientation of existing Merrylands Place Lookout.
 21. Retain shared path - improve drainage in this area by adjusting brick paving levels and adjacent turf levels.
